THE COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN WAS ESTABLISHED BY CONGRESSIONAL ACTION IN 1971. IT IS A PERMANENT, BIPARTISAN, INTERAGENCY COMMISSION WITH MEMBERS FROM THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE, AND JUDICIAL BRANCHES OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Commission on the Status of Women was established by Congress in 1971. It is a permanent, bipartisan, interagency commission with members from the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of the Federal Government. The Commission's mandate is to study and report on the status of women in the United States and to recommend ways to improve it. This report is the Commission's first major report to Congress and the public.

The Commission's work is organized into four major areas: (1) the status of women in the labor force, (2) the status of women in education, (3) the status of women in politics, and (4) the status of women in society. Each area is covered in a separate chapter.

The Commission's findings and recommendations are based on a wide range of data and information, including surveys, studies, and public hearings.
